## Dear Participants,

After a very successful Paper&Grant writing Workshop in March in Berlin, Germany, we would like to invite you to the long awaited follow-up seminar. The "Stiftung für ambulante Psychiatrie und Psychotherapie im Kindes- und Jugendalter - Christian Karl Dieter Moik Stiftung" from Aachen and the editors from European Child and Adolescent Psychiatry (ECAP) support this seminar financially and with their participation.

The aims of this seminar are to follow-up and deepen the paper- and grant-writing skills covered by the last workshop. As expressed in the feedback at the time, even more focus will be laid on the small groups discussions, which were evaluated as central hands-on, practical addition to the theoretical talks. For these peer-to-peer coaching sessions, we ask you to submit a draft of a paper or grant that you are currently working on before 1. September 2014. We will then create thematically linked small groups and distribute the papers prior to the workshop for you to read beforehand. A new addition to this format will be the presence of the editors of ECAP on the second day. They will give overviews over their current research and their past and present paper-writing experiences. Following each talk, there will be ample time to

discuss and ask questions about their personal experiences on how to publish, both as authors and editors. Also, to initiate a more international exchange of young investigators, each editor is invited to bring 1-2 young colleagues from his or her lab to the workshop, so we will meet young researchers from several European neighbor states.

As many travelers come from far away, and the meeting itself is short, we would also like to offer an informal pre-meeting evening in Düsseldorf. This way, we have a second day for getting to know the other participants, exchange of ideas and potential networking. Also, Düsseldorf has good train and flight connections and we will organize a transfer to Rees (1 hour) on Thursday morning.

The workshop is supported by the Christian Karl Dieter Moik Stiftung, so no fees are necessary. However, we would like to point out, that hotel and travel expenses are not covered. Single and double rooms in Rheinpark Hotel (79/99 EUR) are reserved under the Name of YICAP.

In case you want to participate, please let us know, whether you would also like to attend the informal meeting in Düsseldorf on Wednesday or plan to arrive directly to Rees on Thursday. In the former case we will inform you on potential hotels in Düsseldorf and transfer arrangements to Rees the following morning.
